HELPFUL GUIDE FOR FASTING

How you begin and conduct your fast will largely determine your success. For some people, this might be the first time ever to follow a fast or having done one without having a proper understanding or meaning. We are hoping that following these six basic steps to fasting will make your time with the Lord more meaningful and spiritually rewarding.

STEP 1: Set Your Objective

Ask the Holy Spirit to clarify His leading and objectives for your prayer fast. This will enable you to pray more specifically and strategically.

STEP 2: Prepare Yourself Spiritually

The very foundation of fasting and prayer is repentance. Unconfessed sin will hinder your prayers. There are several things you can do to prepare your heart:

- Seek forgiveness from all whom you have offended, and forgive all who have hurt you (Mark 11:25).
- Make restitution as the Holy Spirit leads you.
- Begin your time of fasting and prayer with an expectant heart (Hebrews 11:6).

STEP 3: Prepare Yourself Physically

Physical preparation makes the drastic change in your eating routine a little easier so that you can turn your full attention to the Lord in prayer.

- · Do not rush into your fast.
- Prepare your body. Eat smaller meals before starting a fast. Avoid high-fat and sugary foods.

While You Fast

Your time of fasting and prayer has come. You are abstaining from all solid foods and have begun to seek the Lord. Here are some helpful suggestions to consider:

- · You may drink water during your fast.
- You may find it useful to take mints during the fast to freshen your breath.
- Expect some physical discomforts, especially on the second day.
- You may have fleeting hunger pains or dizziness.

The first two or three days are usually the hardest. As you continue to fast, you will likely experience a sense of well-being both physically and spiritually. However, should you feel hunger pains, increase your liquid intake.

STEP 4: Put Yourself on a Schedule

For maximum spiritual benefit, set aside time to be alone with the Lord. Listen for His leading. The more time you spend with Him, the more meaningful your fast will be.

Morning: Begin your day in praise and worship. Read and meditate on God's Word. Invite the Holy Spirit to work in you. Invite God to use you.

Afternoon: Return to prayer and God's Word. Take a short prayer walk.

Evening: End each day on your knees for a time of praise and thanksgiving to God.

STEP 5: End Your Fast Gradually

Breaking Your Fast

First of all drink water; if possible warm water or beverage to help the digestive tract to relax. After that, you should start off with something light to eat such as fruit; namely bananas or apples. Do not break your fast with fruits such as oranges due to their high acidic content.

STEP 6: Expect Results

If you sincerely humble yourself before the Lord, repent, pray, and seek God's face; if you consistently meditate on His Word, you will experience a heightened awareness of His presence (John 14:21). The Lord will give you a fresh and new spiritual insights. Your confidence and faith in God will be strengthened. You will feel mentally, spiritually and physically refreshed.

WEEK ONE

Authority & Leaders

Governmental Authorities (President, Executive, Legislature & Judiciary)

Key Scriptures: 1 Tim 2:1-4, Romans 13:1, Prov 21:1, Prov 29:2

BRIEF EXHORTATION

Our political leaders need prayer, no matter who they are. And as Paul exhorted Timothy, Christians are called to pray for those "in high positions". As we go about our daily life, the realm of politics often seems so far removed. When we pray for our leaders, we take part in advancing God's kingdom on this earth. They need God's wisdom and guidance to rule, and they face spiritual battles and opposition that they may not be aware of. As Prophet Jeremiah stated, "Seek the peace of the city where I have caused you to be carried away captive, and pray to the Lord for it; for in its peace you will have peace" (*Jeremiah 29:7*)

- 1. Thank God for being the LORD of all flesh; praise Him because He rules in the affairs of all nations.
- 2. Pray for the Spirit of wisdom and sound counsel for the leaders of the nation and declare that God's purposes will be established as they lead.
- Commit the President, Prime Minister, MPs, and all persons in authority to God; ask God to save them and use them as influencers of righteousness in the nation.
- 4. By faith, we rise against every agenda of the enemy against the peace, growth, and development of the nation.
- 5. Father, grant our leaders the ability to distinguish between righteous counsel and the deceitful counsels of the wicked. Surround them with righteous men and women who will give them sound advice. May government halls and buildings around the world be filled with wise counsel and understanding (1 Chronicles 13:1).



The Presiding Bishop & His Family

Key Scriptures: Psalm 89:20-23, 1 Tim 2:1-4

BRIEF EXHORTATION

Our leaders represent us in society and through them, instruction and sound doctrines are given. Because we listen to those in authority, there is a great chance that we are either blessed or misled.

The Father and set man over our lives and all of Victory Bible Church International is Bishop N.A. Tackie-Yarboi.

Without prayer, he will not be able to lead right, and he will not have the strength to carry on the work of the ministry. As the Bible says, we will rejoice if he endures in righteousness.

Some of the greatest scandals that have rocked churches have been as a result of mishaps and misfortunes of leaders. Zechariah 13:7, 'strike the shepherd, and the sheep will scatter'.

Our prayers should stand guard over our shepherds.

- 4. Father, may the ministries of all Resident Pastors and leaders not be a burden unto them. Let their ministries be a great source of strength and joy (*Hebrews 13:17*).
- 5. Father, we pray for sustenance and provision for all Resident Pastors and leaders of the commission. May they not be plagued by lack whilst they serve (*Philippians 4:19*).

Key Scriptures: Matthew 16:18, Ephesians 6:12, 1 Peter 5:8-9

BRIEF EXHORTATION

Key Scriptures: Ephesians 4:12, 1 Corinthians 3:10

BRIEF EXHORTATION

Key Scriptures: 2 Chronicles 7:14, Psalm 85:6, Psalm 80:19

BRIEF EXHORTATION

- 6. Pray for an outbreak of fire of the Holy Ghost that will cause people to continuously speak of God's power.
- 7. Father, raise a victorious army to stand in the gap in our generation, a people who shall call upon You day and night.

More Labourers in Our Churches

Key Scriptures: Matthew 13:30, 39, Luke 10:2, Romans 12:11

BRIEF EXHORTATION

God's expectation is for His children to be involved in the life of His body, the Church. God expects His children to be ever-abounding in the work of the church, and we are given the blessed assurance that our efforts will be recognised by God (1 Corinthians 15:58).

Church workers are the foot soldiers that help to make things happen in any church. Church workers are watchmen in the house of God, they help the pastor to see to it that things continually run smoothly in the House of God.

- Pray that God will send his "reaper angels" to our harvest fields and that He will direct and order our steps, as his co-labourers, into our harvest fields.
- 2. Father, grace VBCI with labourers who will do your work in love with the goal of pleasing You and not other people (1 Corinthians 16:14, Colossians 3:23-24).
- 3. Father, grace VBCI with sacrificial labourers, knowing that their labour in Your house will not be in vain (*Matthew 20:28, Hebrews 6:10*).
- 4. Father, in the Name of Jesus, visit every discouraged worker in this Church, thereby re-establishing them in the faith and in this church, this year.
- 5. Father, in the Name of Jesus, stir up the zeal of every church worker in VBCI to engage in kingdom advancement endeavours, resulting in the supernatural multiplication of this Church.
- Father, we come against any power or principality hindering labourers from our Churches.



Unity in the Body

Key Scriptures: Eph .4:1-6, 1 Cor. 12:12, Romans 15:5-6, Psalm 133:1

BRIEF EXHORTATION

God wants His body to be one, united and be very formidable in order to achieve the goal of the great commission (*Matthew 28:19-20*) and so that Satan will not be able to touch the hinder part of it. Unity means oneness of Spirit, Purpose & Body. It means everyone is following the same course with the same motives and mutual expectations.

When the body of Christ operates in disunity, it paints a false picture of God to the world and hinders the work of God. As stated in *Mark 3:25*, "And if a house is divided against itself, that house cannot stand."

- 1. Pray and bind every spirit of disunity and betrayal from infiltrating God's people.
- Father, visit our church with the spirit of unity and oneness like You did in the early church, in Jesus Name.
- 3. Father, we uproot every seed of discord the enemy has sown or is trying to sow in our Church in the name of Jesus Christ.
- 4. Father, we receive the grace to walk in forgiveness and not hold people in offense thus cementing the bond of unity.
- Father frustrate the efforts and works of those who are gathering against us to sow seeds of discord.
- 6. Ask God to help every member of the church to live in harmony with each other. May we be united in love and enable us to pray with the Mind of Christ (*1 Corinthians 12:25*).
- 7. Father enable us to see eachother through the eyes of love (the eyes of God) in Jesus' Name (Ephesians 5:1-2).

Personal Supplications

Spiritual Growth & Stability

Key Scriptures: Ephesians 1:17-18, Hebrews 5:12, Joshua 1:8

BRIEF EXHORTATION

Spiritual growth is the process of developing a closer relationship with God through prayers, His word, His presence and His power. Spiritual growth begins with Spiritual desire (1 Peter 2:1-3).

The Holy Spirit teaches us all that we need to know concerning who we are, our walk, our work and what we are to do (*John 14:26*).

When the Spirit of God produces a desire for spiritual growth, spiritual discipline will always follow.

- Lord, renew my spiritual desire for growth and passion to dwell in your presence.
- Father, grant me the Spirit of wisdom and better revelation in the knowledge of you, help me to have a rich understanding of who You are, in Jesus' Name.
- 3. Lord, let the anointing of the Holy Spirit break every yoke of spiritual dullness in my life, in the Name of Jesus.
- 4. Father, I pray for strength in my inner man by Your spirit that I may be rooted, grounded and established in Your love in Jesus Name. (*Ephesians 3:16-19*)
- 5. Lord grant me utterance to make known the mystery of the Gospel, in the Name of Jesus. Perfect Your good work in me, create a hunger and desire in me for your Word, prayer, and Your work.
- 6. Father, I come against anything that chokes Your word in my life in the Mighty Name of Jesus (*Mark 4:19*).
- 7. Father, create in me a fresh desire for Your presence, Your word and Your power in Jesus' Name.
- 8. Father establish my feet on your stable grounds, in Jesus' Name.



Families, Marriages & Children

Key Scriptures: Genesis 2:21-24, Genesis 1:28, Psalm 127:3

BRIEF EXHORTATION

Marriage is the first institution that was established by God. Marriage is the beginning of families and children. If the enemy is able to target the marriage, he will get the children and family. Our work is to build a hedge of protection around our marriages, our children and our families.

- 1. Father, I thank you for the institution of marriage.

- 4. In the name of Jesus, I will locate or be located by the flesh of my flesh and the bone of my bone. I refuse to take on any strange flesh or bone. (*Genesis 2:23*)
- 5. I command, in the name of Jesus, every evil force militating against the blessings of my family to die right now!
- 6. I command every generational curse and demonic altar against my family to be consumed by the fire of God. No evil is permitted to befall my family in Jesus' Name.
- This year 2023, we decree a relase of miracle babies to families desiring children in Jesus' Mighty Name.
- 8. I declare that my children and the future generation will manifest God's blessings and favour in Jesus Mighty Name.
- 9. I declare that my family is blessed beyond measure in Jesus Name.



Business and Career Advancement

Key Scriptures: Genesis 26:12-14, 3 John 2, Romans 12:11

BRIEF EXHORTATION

Success and growth is God's desire for all His children. In the Book of *3 John 2*, God made it clear that His greatest desire is to see us succeed on every front. To succeed means to grow and growth means progress. As a child of God, God wants you to enlarge your coast, He wants you to burst forth on every side.

- 1. Father, I ask for supernatural wisdom as I go about my business in Jesus Name.
- 2. I declare that my business shall flourish after the order of Isaac in Jesus' Name (*Genesis 26:13*).
- 3. I receive Divine prosperity, business success and job promotion.
- 4. Father, let the anointing of prosperity fall on me, in the Name of Jesus.
- Every demonic spirit seeking to take my job, my career and my promotion from me, I command your works to be destroyed in Jesus' Name.
- 6. Father, you have given us power to create wealth; I ask You to give me the power, wisdom, ideas, inspiration, guidance and divine strategies to create wealth in my life in Jesus' Name (*Deuteronomy 8:18*).
- 7. Oh Lord, connect me with my destiny helpers and may they not rest until they locate and fulfill all Your plans in my life in the Name of Jesus. (*Psalm 5:12*)
- 8. Father in the name of Jesus, Your prosperity or blessing in my life will not lead to sorrow in Jesus Name (*Proverbs 10:22*).

Financial Liberty

Key Scriptures: Isaiah 45:3-4, Deuteronomy 28:12

BRIEF EXHORTATION

It is God's will and desire that you will have financial liberty, prosper, and lend to others (*3 John 2*). It is, however, the strategy of the enemy to ensure that you are financially handicapped so that your potentials do not manifest. Debt is an evil thing that keeps you in the cycle of poverty. - 5. Father, bless the work of my hands; with abundance to show for it and let me not labour in vain. (*Psalm 90:17, Isaiah 65:23*).
- 6. Father, I ask for creative wisdom that can be monetized to pay off any existing debt in the Name of Jesus. I declare I shall be a lender and not a borrower. (*Proverbs 22:7*)
- Let any cycle of financial instability in my life and that of my family be broken and cast away in the Name of Jesus.
- 8. Father empower me to leave an inheritance to many generations in the Name of Jesus (*Proverbs 13:22*).

Protection and Deliverance

Key Scriptures: Psalm 91, Zechariah, John 10:30, Luke 10:19

BRIEF EXHORTATION

Divine protection and deliverance is part of your salvation package and it comes from God alone. 'Sozo' is a greek word that means 'saved, healed and delivered'. Sozo contains the total package of being made whole or well. In the gospel, salvation is not only for eternal life but also for physical healing and deliverance. The moment you accepted Jesus Christ as your Lord and personal saviour, you inherited the right to be protected, healed and delivered by God.

- 1. Father, I thank you for the gift of life and sound health in Jesus' Name.
- 2. Father, according to your Word, continue to be a protective wall of fire around me and my family, so we shall never be victims of the enemy in Jesus' Name (*Zechariah 2:5*).
- Every demonic claim of the earth over my life, be dismantled, in Jesus' Name.
- All curses and demons, programmed against me, I neutralise you by the Blood of Jesus.
- 5. Father, I command every power preventing Your perfect will from being done in my life to receive failure in the Name of Jesus.
- 6. Father in the Name of Jesus, according to your word in *Isaiah 54:1*, I pray that every one that is planning against me and plotting to harm me shall fall for my sake, in the Name of Jesus Christ.
- Every voice that is speaking against me and my family, be silenced right now in the Name of Jesus.
- I declare because I dwell in God's secret place, I am untouchable to the enemy in the Name of Jesus.

Mercy and Help From Above

Key Scriptures: Psalm 121:1-8, Lamentations 3:22-23, Hebrews 4:16

BRIEF EXHORTATION

God's mercy and help is available to us, but we often have a difficult time receiving it each day. His mercies are renewed every morning. No one is perfect and we all fall short daily. Divine help is real, and it is the heritage of every believer in Christ. It is a help that never fails as it comes on time; it is never too early and never too late.

Stop seeking help where there is none, or from the wrong source. God is our refuge and strength. He is a very present help (*Psalm 46:1*). A help that is not present when you need it, is of small value.

- 8. Father, I call unto You and I ask that You help me in ... (mention specific situation) (*Jeremiah 33:3, Psalm 46:1*).

You have the power to loose and bind on Earth and in Heaven (*Matthew 16:19*). When you decree a thing, it shall be established unto you (*Job 22:28*). The angels of God are always at your disposable to bring into manifestation the plans and purposes of God in your life, but it is your responsibility to speak those things into being. Even God in creation spoke

- "Let there be" and there was.

Speak and enforce that this is your year of Power to Reign!

- Father, Your word declares that I am a priest and king unto you, I pray for understanding to act out my kingly and priestly rights and privileges on Earth in Jesus' Name (*Revelation 1:6*).
